
Survey—a survey was sent to all families. Your input assists us in our planning and I encourage you to complete this—it's a short survey.

ROOM 7 NEWS




In HASS, we have been learning about the continents of Africa and South America, and some of the countries on those continents.


In Art, we have been working on a project with Mrs. Tero that will help display our feelings about our very own school garden.
